



2020 DALLAS HALF-MILE I & II DOUBLEHEADER WEEKEND At Devil's Bowl Speedway

1. When is the 2020 DALLAS HALF-MILE I & II doubleheader?

AFT's Dallas Half-Mile I & II doubleheader is scheduled to run on Friday, Sept. 25th & Saturday, Sept. 26th, 2020.

3. Health & Safety Information:

WHAT PROTOCOLS AND PROCEDURES WILL BE IN PLACE TO ENSURE FANS' SAFETY?

We are working with local and state health and government officials to ensure the venue will be ready to provide a safe experience for all American Flat Track fans in attendance. Amended safety protocols and procedures will be in effect that include, but are not limited to:

- Enforcing a limited venue capacity of 50%.
- Strict adherence to the CDC-recommended 6' social distancing will be mandated onsite.
- A maximum of 10 seats grouped together will be allowed.
- Per local authorities, all guests (age 3 and up) will be required to bring and wear face coverings. Masks will be provided at the screening location.
- A sequenced ingress/egress procedure into the facility property/gates will be used to minimize large concentrations of personnel or guests.
- Each guest will be screened prior to entering the event gates; initial screening will include a non-contact temperature check.
- Entry and exit to the grandstands, along with routes to concession stands and restrooms will adhere to social distancing guidelines.
- Multiple handwashing and hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the venue and entrances.
- A cleaning staff, clearly identified for guests, will be cleaning or disinfecting at all times.
- Once inside the venue, fans will not be allowed to exit the property and return (no re-entry).
- All transactions will be cashless. Accepted forms of payment: Debit, Visa, Mastercard, American Express, and Discover.

4. When do gates open for fans?

4:30 PM on Friday, September 25th

4:30 PM on Saturday, September 26th

5. Can you bring coolers into the Devil's Bowl Speedway?

No coolers will be allowed inside the venue at this event.

6. Can you bring food or beverages into the Devil's Bowl Speedway?

No outside food or beverage allowed, except for bottled water.

7. Are campers allowed into the Devil's Bowl Speedway?

There will be no camping, overnight parking, or tailgating allowed.

8. Are pets allowed into the Devil's Bowl Speedway?

Only licensed service animals wearing a vest and with owner carrying license are permitted inside the Devil's Bowl Speedway.

9. Is the Devil's Bowl Speedway handicap/wheelchair accessible?

Yes, both the General Admission Grandstands and the Premium GA Grandstand areas along the frontstretch are ADA accessible along the ground level.

10. Do you have a Military/First Responders discount? Would the discount be available the date of the race?

Yes, discount codes are available using www.GovX.com for online ticket purchases. Discounts will also be available at the gate with proper Military/First Responder identification. Military/First Responder tickets are available in the regular General Admission areas.

11. Which tickets include Food & Beverage service and at what times?

Due to COVID-19 safety restrictions and current local government guidelines, there will be no tickets sold inclusive of food or beverage.

12. Will the Public be allowed access to the Paddock/Pit areas for this event?

Unfortunately, no. As we worked hard to design protocols that made it safe for us to come back to racing, the difficult decision was made to restrict all outside access to our pit/paddock area for the safety of competitors, teams and fans. This rule will be strictly enforced. Only essential paddock personnel pre-approved by AFT will be allowed admittance to this area.

- **PREMIUM Suite #1: \$600** (plus service fee & tax)

15. How can I receive my advance purchased tickets?

ALL admission tickets for this event will be delivered via Digital Download upon purchase. For customers experiencing issues with receiving their emailed tickets, advance paid admission may also be verified and claimed via Will Call check-in on the day of the event.

Due to COVID-19 public safety restrictions and current local government guidelines, and in order to minimize person-to-person contact and potential spread, THIS EVENT will use either DIGITAL TICKET DELIVERY or WILL CALL check-in for ALL advance admission purchases.

**This event is a contact-less Ticketed Entry event. Digital Ticket images (with barcodes) may be presented on-site via either mobile device or personally-generated paper printout.*

16. Where can I check in via WILL CALL admission on the day of the race?

Advance ticketholders requiring admission assistance via WILL CALL check-in may check in on race day at AFTE's clearly designated WILL CALL booth, located immediately on-site at Devil's Bowl Speedway.

17. Are Children 12 & Under free?

Yes, Children 12 and under are FREE in the REGULAR General Admission areas with a minimum purchase of one (1) PAID Adult Regular GA ticket.

18. What are the items that I can or cannot bring to Devil's Bowl Speedway?

While some of these guidelines may not historically be considered standard regulations for this venue, due to COVID-19 safety restrictions and current local government guidelines, there will be *no camping, overnight parking, or tailgating allowed.*

ITEMS PERMITTED INSIDE DEVIL'S BOWL SPEEDWAY PARK:

Clear Bags that are 18" x 18" x 14" or less in size (1 per person)
Small Non-Clear Purses/Handbags (Clutch Type Bags) that are 4.5"x 6.5" or less in size (1 per person)
Cell Phones
Extra Clothes
Sunscreen & Bug Spray (Non-Aerosol Cans only)
Small Personal Blankets
NOTE: ALL BAGS/PURSES SUBJECT TO SEARCH

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

Any type of non-clear bags exceeding 4.5" x 6.5" in size
(Including purses or handbags, camera or binocular cases, backpacks, fanny packs, diaper bags, briefcases or computer bags)
Outside food or beverage
Coolers and Ice Packs
Grills or cooking equipment
WEAPONS, KNIVES OR FIREARMS (NO EXCEPTIONS)
Fireworks, chains, glass
Selfie Sticks
Video / Recording Equipment
Remote Controlled Flying Devices / Drones / UAVs
Oversized Umbrellas or Umbrellas with a tip
Lawn Chairs or Inflatable Seating Units
Rollerboards, Skateboards


- *All items brought through the gate areas are subject to inspection by security and event officials.*
- *NO Weapons, Firearms, Fireworks, or Illegal Substances or items restricted by local, state and federal laws.*

We must ask that you respect and obey these rules as you spend time at Devil's Bowl Speedway. Failure to do so could result in adjusting the location of your seating, or you (and/or your group) being required to leave the premises (no refunds.)

19. What else is there to do at the track during the race weekend?

There will be an open-air fan vendor zone where fans can walk around and view different products, services and displays. Fans should also be sure to stop by the Official AFT Merchandise booth to grab the latest American Flat Track gear and event merchandise.

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
