1. When is the 2021 VOLUSIA HALF-MILE I & II doubleheader?

AFT's Volusia Half-Mile I & II doubleheader is scheduled to run on Friday, March 12th, 2021 & Saturday, March 13th, 2021.

3. Health & Safety Information:

WHAT PROTOCOLS AND PROCEDURES WILL BE IN PLACE TO ENSURE FANS' SAFETY?

We are working with Volusia County health and government officials to ensure the venue will be ready to provide a safe experience for all American Flat Track fans in attendance. Amended safety protocols and procedures will be in effect that include, but are not limited to:

- Enforcing a limited venue capacity
- Strict adherence to the CDC-recommended 6' social distancing will be mandated onsite
- A maximum of 10 seats grouped together will be allowed
- All guests (age 3 and up) will be required to wear face coverings. Masks will be provided at the screening location upon entry for fans that may do not wish to bring their own.
- A sequenced ingress/egress procedure into the facility property/gates will be used to minimize large concentrations of personnel or guests
- Each guest will be screened prior to entering the event gates; initial screening will include a non-contact temperature check
- Entry and exit to the grandstands, along with routes to concession stands and restrooms will adhere to social distancing guidelines
- Multiple handwashing and hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the venue and entrances
- A cleaning staff, clearly identified for guests, will be cleaning or disinfecting at all times
- Once inside the venue, fans will not be allowed to exit the property and return (no re-entry)
- All transactions will be cashless preferred. Accepted forms of payment: Debit, Visa, Mastercard, American Express, and Discover. Cash payments must be via exact change.

5. Can you bring coolers into the Volusia Speedway?

Small coolers measuring 14" x 14" x 14" or less will be permitted.

6. Can you bring food or beverages into the Volusia Speedway?

No outside food or beverage allowed, except for bottled water.

7. Camping Information

Are campers allowed into the Volusia Speedway?

Per current COVID-19 safety restrictions and current local government guidelines, paid camping is now allowed at Volusia Speedway Park for the Volusia Half-Mile doubleheader event weekend.

Camping passes do not include admission ticket(s) to the event. Daily event admission must be purchased separately for each race attendee in the camping party.

Premium Reserved *Covered* Camping - \$800 per weekend, (plus tax and service fee)

- Covered camping area close to track
- Reserved, numbered space
- Water & electric hook-up

Premium Reserved Hook-up Camping - \$500 per weekend, (plus tax and service fee)

- Spots closest to track
- Reserved, numbered space
- Water & electric hook-up

Reserved Hook-up Camping - \$500 per weekend, (plus tax and service fee)

- Reserved, numbered space
- Water, electric & sewer hook-up

General Admission Area - \$100 per weekend, (plus tax and service fee)

- First come, first serve spaces
- No hook-ups

Additional Camping Information

Weekend camping sales only (no single day passes available for sale)

- **Load-in opens at 9:00 AM on Thursday, 3/11**
- **Load-out by 5:00 PM Sunday 3/14**

8. What are the safety protocols and criteria for campers?

Camping spots will be spaced out to allow for social distancing. A maximum of 6 guests are allowed per spot for a total of three (3) nights (Thursday, Friday & Saturday). When in their own designated spot with their own party, masks will not be required for camping guests. However, if outside of their designated spot, guests are strongly encouraged to wear a mask and maintain a 6' minimum distance from other guests.

All camping guests will go through identical screening as single-day ticketholders upon entry to Volusia Speedway Park property. No other camping on property is allowed. If anyone in a group does not pass the screening/non-contact temperature check, the entire party will not be permitted to stay on Volusia Speedway Park property.

Signage will be visible throughout the campgrounds regarding social distancing and other protocols guests must abide by.

While on Volusia Speedway Park property, campers are required to stay in their camping area. If campers must exit Volusia Speedway Park property in their tow vehicle for any reason, they will go through additional screenings upon exit and re-entry before being allowed back to their designated camping spots.

9. What happens if a fan falls ill during the event?

There will be dedicated medical assets resourced to provide treatment of any fan(s) developing symptoms during the event. In addition, a robust disinfecting / decontamination capability has been established for immediate on-site response. Finally, local public health officials will be notified of the potential infection.

10. Are overnight parking or tailgating allowed in other areas of Volusia Speedway Park?

Outside of the designated camping areas, there is no other overnight parking or tailgating permitted at Volusia Speedway Park for this event.

11. Are pets allowed into the Volusia Speedway?

Only licensed service animals wearing a vest and with owner carrying license are permitted inside the Volusia Speedway.

12. Is the Volusia Speedway handicap/wheelchair accessible?

Yes, the large General Admission area along the frontstretch is ADA accessible. The T1 GA area and other frontstretch GA areas are accessible at ground level.

13. Do you have a Military/First Responders discount? Would the discount be available the date of the race?

Yes, discount codes are available using www.Govx.com for online ticket purchases. Discounts will also be available at the gate with proper Military/First Responder identification. Military/First Responder tickets are available in the regular General Admission areas.

14. Which tickets include Food & Beverage service and at what times?

Due to COVID-19 safety restrictions and current local government guidelines, there will be no tickets sold inclusive of food or beverage.

15. Will the Public be allowed access to the Paddock/Pit areas for this event?

Unfortunately, no. As we worked hard to design protocols that made it safe for us to come back to racing, the difficult decision was made to restrict all outside access to our pit/paddock area for the safety of competitors, teams and fans. This rule will be strictly enforced. Only essential paddock personnel pre-approved by AFT will be allowed admittance to this area.

16. Ticket Pricing:

General Admission: \$33 (plus service fee & tax), Children 12 & under FREE

General Admission PREMIUM: Adult \$60, Children 12 & Under \$20 (plus service fee & tax)

Turn 1 GA Grandstand (Per Person Walk-In): \$33 (plus service fee & tax), Children 12 & under FREE

***Reserved Trackside Parking: \$65** (plus service fee & tax)

**RESERVED PARKING does not include Race Admission. Turn 1 GA Area Admission ticket(s) must also be purchased for each attendee in the vehicle to enter the Reserved Trackside Parking Area.*

18. How can I receive my advance purchased tickets?

ALL admission tickets for this event will be delivered via Digital Download upon purchase. For customers experiencing issues with receiving their emailed tickets, advance paid admission may also be verified and claimed via Will-Call check-in on the day of the event. Due to COVID-19 public safety restrictions and current local government guidelines, and in order to minimize person-to-person contact and potential spread, THIS EVENT will use either DIGITAL TICKET DELIVERY or WILL CALL check-in for ALL advance admission purchases.

**This event is a Paperless Ticketed Entry event. Digital Ticket images (with barcodes) may be presented on-site via either mobile device or personally-generated paper printout.*

19. Where can I check in via WILL-CALL admission on the day of the race?

Advance ticketholders requiring admission assistance via WILL-CALL check-in may check in on race day at AFTE's clearly designated WILL CALL booth, located immediately on-site at Volusia Speedway.

20. Are Children 12 & Under free?

Yes, Children 12 and under are FREE in the REGULAR General Admission areas with a minimum purchase of one (1) PAID Adult Regular GA ticket.

21. What are the items that I can or cannot bring to Volusia Speedway Park?

While some of these guidelines may not historically be considered standard regulations for this venue, due to COVID-19 safety restrictions and current local government guidelines, there will be *no camping, overnight parking, or tailgating allowed.*

ITEMS PERMITTED INSIDE VOLUSIA SPEEDWAY PARK:

Clear Bags that are 18" x 18" x 14" or less in size (1 per person)

Small Non-Clear Purses/Handbags (Clutch Type Bags) that are 4.5"x 6.5" or less in size (1 per person)

Small coolers measuring 14" x 14" x 14" or less

Cell Phones

Extra Clothes

Sunscreen & Bug Spray (Non-Aerosol Cans only)

Small Personal Blankets

NOTE: ALL BAGS/PURSES SUBJECT TO SEARCH

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

Any type of non-clear bags exceeding 4.5" x 6.5" in size -

(Including purses or handbags, camera or binocular cases, backpacks, fanny packs, diaper bags, briefcases or computer bags)

Outside food or beverage (except for bottled water)

Grills or cooking equipment

WEAPONS, KNIVES OR FIREARMS (NO EXCEPTIONS)

Fireworks, chains, glass

Selfie Sticks

Video/Recording Equipment

Remote Controlled Flying Devices / Drones / UAVs

Oversized Umbrellas or Umbrellas with a tip

Lawn Chairs or Inflatable Seating Units

Rollerboards, Skateboards

- *All items brought through the gate areas are subject to inspection by security and event officials.*
- *NO Weapons, Firearms, Fireworks, or Illegal Substances or items restricted by local, state and federal laws*

We must ask that you respect and obey these rules as you spend time at Volusia Speedway. Failure to do so could result in adjusting the location of your seating/site, or you (and/or your group) being required to leave the premises (no refunds.)


22. What else is there to do at the track during the race weekend?
