CRF450R (2020-2022 models)

Requirements:

- Bodywork with standard production colors must be predominantly featured on the machine.
- Honda logo must be legible and prominently featured on the machine.
- Honda logo must be located on both sides of either the seat, radiator shrouds or front and rear fender.

How to Register:

- All Honda contingency awards will be paid via XTRM AnyPay™ digital wallet.
- Competitors have 45 days from the date of the race to inquire about missing payments.
- Competitors MUST enroll and verify registered VIN for qualifying vehicles.

- The Husqvarna Motorcycles logo must be displayed on both left and right side of the motorcycle tank/shroud and front and rear fender area of the plastic components for contingency eligibility.
 - The original colors of the Husqvarna Motorcycles models must be predominant to be eligible.

Eligible Kawasaki Engines Must be Verified by Kawasaki

- Kawasaki Lime Green must be the dominant color
- Kawasaki logos <u>must</u> (black or white only) be on both sides of the motorcycle.
- Kawasaki <u>must</u> be on the chest portion of leathers. Patches can be purchased or requested from Team Green at https://www.kawasaki.com/.
- Prior to enrolling, participants must contact Team Green at 949-716-0351 for additional information about how to enroll.
- Registration for the program is online at https://www.kawasakisalesrewards.com/.
- Contact Team Green Racer Rewards to submit a photo of the race bike at teamgreen.contingency@kmc-usa.com in order to enroll.
- In addition to registration, riders must submit a signed <u>W-9 form</u> to teamgreen.contingency@kmc-usa.com.
- Following registration, riders should receive the Kawasaki Racer Rewards MasterCard® (debit card) within 7-10 business days once registration has been approved.
- Automatic payments will be deposited directly to your MasterCard® after Kawasaki receives and approves "official" race results from the event promoter.

- Only motorcycles containing a genuine KTM Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) are eligible.
- The KTM logo must be displayed on both the left and right side of the motorcycle tank/shroud and front and rear gender area of the plastic components for contingency eligibility.
 - KTM orange must be the dominant color of the motorcycle.
- Must ride a KTM motorcycle for the entire series to be eligible for series-end results.

Yamaha

YZ450F Motorcycles (2020 - 2022)

- The "Yamaha" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the left and right side of all motorcycles and the "bLU cRU" logo must be displayed on the front number plate of all machines to be eligible.
- The original color plastic components must remain on all units to be eligible.
- The "Yamaha" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the chest of the rider's leathers and "bLU cRU" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the rider's right shoulder to be eligible.
- Contingency will be paid to the Warranty Registered owner. If warranty registered owner will not be competing, but sponsoring a rider, contingency will be paid to the rider.
- Contingency will be paid on rider's best finish in one class only, per registered machine.
- There will be no multiple class payouts at the same event for the same machine.
- Riders must submit a 2022 Contingency Registration form by November 30, 2022 to be eligible.
- In addition to registration, riders must submit a signed W-9 form.
- Upon 2022 registration approval, NEW bLU cRU members will receive a reloadable Yamaha "bLU cRU" debit card within 4 to 6 weeks.
- All registered winning riders will be issued credit to their reloadable Yamaha "bLU cRU" debit card after Yamaha receives confirmation of results from promoter and rider has completed a registration form and valid I.R.S. W-9 form.
- Winning riders must have a valid U.S. social security number to be eligible.

Motion Pro

Motion Pro Branded Tool or Product Use

- Competitor must post at least 1 permanent post (not story) on competitors own Instagram of a Motion Pro Tire Pressure Gauge (or another Motion Pro Product) in use on RIDER's competition bike. Post must tag @motionpro directly into the post as well as including @motionpro in the text of the post.
