- Honda logo must be located on both sides of either the seat, radiator shrouds or front and rear fender.

- All Honda contingency awards will be paid via XTRM AnyPay™ digital wallet.
- Competitors have 45 days from the date of the race to inquire about missing payments.
- Competitors MUST enroll and verify registered VIN for qualifying vehicles.

- Husqvarna Motorcycles Logo <u>must</u> be displayed on both left and right side of the motorcycles tank/shroud area, front and rear fender.
- Husqvarna Motorcycles Logo <u>must</u> be displayed on riders left chest of leathers, at a minimum of 3.5".
- Husqvarna standard colors <u>must</u> remain the dominant color of the motorcycle.
 Motorcycles body work/plastics with standard colors must be predominant.
- Rider <u>must</u> ride a Husqvarna motorcycle for the entire series to be eligible for series-end results.
- Professional class cash winnings from valid professional-level classes will be paid via payment to a Debit Card in the US. All cash payouts are paid within 30 days from the time your results are verified.

Eligible Kawasaki Engines Must be Verified by Kawasaki

- Kawasaki Lime Green must be the dominant color
- Kawasaki logos <u>must</u> (black or white only) be on both sides of the motorcycle.
- Kawasaki <u>must</u> be on the chest portion of leathers. Patches can be purchased or requested from Team Green at https://www.kawasaki.com/.
- Prior to enrolling, participants must contact Team Green at 949-716-0351 for additional information about how to enroll.

- Contact Team Green Racer Rewards to submit a photo of the race bike at teamgreen.contingency@kmc-usa.com in order to enroll.
- In addition to registration, riders must submit a signed <u>W-9 form</u> to <u>teamgreen.contingency@kmc-usa.com</u>.
- Following registration, riders should receive the Kawasaki Racer Rewards MasterCard® (debit card) within 7-10 business days once registration has been approved.

- KTM Logo <u>must</u> be displayed on riders left chest of leathers, at a minimum of 3.5".
- KTM Orange <u>must</u> remain the dominant color of the motorcycle. Motorcycles body work/plastics with standard colors must be predominant.
- KTM Logo <u>must</u> be ORANGE when using a dark background color, or BLACK when using a light or orange background. "KTM Orange" Panton 021 c / RAL 2009 / 0/75/100/0.
- Rider <u>must</u> ride a KTM motorcycle for the entire series to be eligible for series-end results.
- Professional class cash winnings from valid professional-level classes will be paid via payment to a Debit Card in the US. All cash payouts are paid within 30 days from the time your results are verified.
- Only competing rider will be eligible for KTM Contingency.

YZ450F Motorcycles (2022 - 2024)

- The "Yamaha" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the left and right side of all motorcycles. The
 original color plastic components must remain on all AFT Singles class motorcycles to be
 eligible.
- The "Yamaha" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the chest of the rider's leathers and "bLU cRU" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the rider's right shoulder to be eligible.
- Contingency will be paid to the Warranty Registered owner. If warranty registered owner will not be competing, but sponsoring a rider, contingency will be paid to the rider.
- Contingency will be paid on rider's best finish in one class only, per registered machine.
- There will be no multiple class payouts at the same event for the same machine.
- AFT Singles riders can sign up for Contingency through Yamaha
- All riders must submit a signed <u>W-9 form</u> and have signed up on the website by November 30, 2024
- Upon 2024 registration approval, NEW bLU cRU members will receive a reloadable Yamaha "bLU cRU" debit card within 4 to 6 weeks.
- All registered winning riders will be issued credit to their reloadable Yamaha "bLU cRU" debit card after Yamaha receives confirmation of results from promoter and rider has completed a registration form and valid I.R.S. W-9 form.
- Winning riders must have a valid U.S. social security number to be eligible.
