 Race a H-D XG750R or XR750 at all races in which their team participates in the 2024 season.

Harley-Davidson

Harley-Davidson XR750 / XG750R

- Display the Harley-Davidson logo on both sides of the fuel tank and/or tail section of the race bike. Minimum size on the motorcycle should be no less 6 inches wide with scaled height. H-D will provide decals through Progressive AFT. Any additional tank or tail logos must be approved by Harley-Davidson. Contact Ashley Robinson (arobinson@amaproracing.com) for details.
- Display the Harley-Davidson patch on the upper chest (either side) and both shoulders of leathers. H-D will provide patches through Progressive AFT. Contact Ashley Robinson (arobinson@amaproracing.com) for details.
- Submit intentions to participate in the contingency program via email no less than one week prior to the participant's first race to H-D Contingency Racing Team (contingencyracing@harley-Davidson.com).
- Post to their primary social media channels (including Instagram, Twitter, Facebook,
 YouTube and/or TikTok) images or video showing that at least two of the above logo
 requirements have been met on race day, within two days following each race, tagging
 @harleydavidson and using #HDRacer.

- Race only an Indian FTR 750 at all races the team participates in for the 2024 AFT Super Twins.
- Follow leather and motorcycle tank branding requirements.
- Photo submittal required of leathers and tank panel for 2024 contingency 1 week prior to your first race to: racing@indianmotorcycle.com
- Mention Indian Motorcycle Racing in podium speech if applicable.
- NEW! Post to social media channels (Instagram, Twitter, Facebook, YouTube, and/or TikTok) images, reels, and/or videos, including the Indian Motorcycle logos on your race bike, within two days following each race, tagging @indianmotorcycle and using #indianmotorcycle.
- For contingency payouts email <u>racing@Indianmotorcycle.com</u> to request a payment setup form. Return payment setup form along with W-9 to <u>racing@Indianmotorcycle.com</u>
- After each qualifying event submit a PDF invoice to Indian Motorcycle Racing for the teams earned contingency amount to racing@indianmotorcycle.com
- All payments will be made within 45 days. Payments will be issued via check and sent out by U.S. Postal Service on Thursdays. No payments will be issued after December 15, 2024.

Eligible Kawasaki Engines Must be Verified by Kawasaki

- Kawasaki Lime Green <u>must</u> be the dominant color
- Kawasaki logos <u>must</u> (black or white only) be on both sides of the motorcycle.
- Kawasaki <u>must</u> be on the chest portion of leathers. Patches can be purchased or requested from Team Green at <u>https://www.kawasaki.com/</u>.
- Prior to enrolling, participants must contact Team Green at 949-716-0351 for additional information about how to enroll.
- Registration for the program is online at https://www.kawasakisalesrewards.com/.
- Contact Team Green Racer Rewards to submit a photo of the race bike at teamgreen.contingency@kmc-usa.com in order to enroll.
- In addition to registration, riders must submit a signed <u>W-9 form</u> to <u>teamgreen.contingency@kmc-usa.com</u>.
- Following registration, riders should receive the Kawasaki Racer Rewards MasterCard® (debit card) within 7-10 business days once registration has been approved.
- Automatic payments will be deposited directly to your MasterCard® after Kawasaki receives and approves "official" race results from the event promoter.

Requirements:

- KTM 790 and 890 Duke engines only are eligible.
- KTM Logo <u>must</u> be displayed on both left and right side of the motorcycles tank/shroud area and rear fender, minimum size is 4".

KTM

Duke 790 and Duke 890

- KTM Logo <u>must</u> be displayed on riders left chest of leathers, at a minimum of 3.5".
- Best efforts are encouraged to design race bikes to be identifiable as KTM 790 and 890 Dukes.
- KTM Orange <u>must</u> remain the dominant color of the motorcycle
- KTM Logo <u>must</u> be ORANGE when using a dark background color, or BLACK when using a light or orange background. "KTM Orange" – Panton 021 c / RAL 2009 / 0/75/100/0.
- Rider <u>must</u> ride a KTM motorcycle for the entire series to be eligible for series-end results.
- Professional class cash winnings from valid professional-level classes will be paid via payment to a Debit Card in the US. All cash payouts are paid within 30 days from the time your results are verified.
- Only competing rider will be eligible for KTM Contingency.

Yamaha MT-07 Engines

- The "Yamaha" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the left and right side of all motorcycles. The original color plastic components must remain on all AFT Singles class motorcycles to be eligible.
- The "Yamaha" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the chest of the rider's leathers and "bLU cRU" logo <u>must</u> be displayed on the rider's right shoulder to be eligible.
- Contingency will be paid to the Warranty Registered owner. If warranty registered owner will not be competing, but sponsoring a rider, contingency will be paid to the rider.
- Contingency will be paid on rider's best finish in one class only, per registered machine.
- There will be no multiple class payouts at the same event for the same machine.
- **SuperTwins riders** must submit a 2024 <u>AFT Contingency Registration form</u> and W-9 to be eligible, please send the form and W-9 to <u>racing contingency@yamaha-motor.com</u>
- All riders must submit a signed <u>W-9 form</u> and have signed up by the registration form (SuperTwins) by November 30, 2024.
- Winning riders must have a valid U.S. social security number to be eligible.
