8. Is Daytona International Speedway handicap/wheelchair accessible?

9. Will fans be allowed access to the Pit areas for this event?

Yes, paddock access is included with every event ticket purchase.

13. What else is there to do at the track during the race weekend?

There will be an open-air fan vendor zone, featuring numerous bike displays and other exhibits. Fans should also be sure to stop by the Official AFT Merchandise booth to grab the latest American Flat Track gear and event merchandise.

14. What are the items that I can or cannot bring to Daytona International Speedway?**ITEMS PERMITTED INSIDE DAYTONA INTERNATIONAL SPEEDWAY:**

1 clear plastic bag that does not exceed 18" x 18" x 4"

1 small soft-sided cooler that does not exceed 6" x 6" x 12"

Sunscreen, sunblock, hand sanitizer, & bug spray (Aerosol, gel, or liquid forms)

Pre-packaged and sealed food and beverage items in bag or soft sided cooler, including alcoholic beverages (No glass containers)

Ice (Dry ice is prohibited)

Insulated cups (i.e. YETI, Tervis) – 64 oz. maximum

Earplugs, earmuffs, or other types of hearing protection

Cameras, binoculars, scanners, and headsets that can be worn over the neck, belt, or carried inside of one of the bags

iPads, tablets, and laptop computers

Seat cushions without metal components (Seat cushions with zippers or pockets will be reviewed on an individual basis)

Cigarettes and lighters

Strollers are admitted, but not in the seating areas (Stroller storage areas are located at Guest Services booths inside the venue)

Blankets and additional clothing

Service animals (Pertaining to service dogs & service miniature horses only)

Nationality flags attached to a pencil-sized wooden stick (Flags may not obstruct any other fan's view of the event)

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

Hard-sided coolers regardless of size (Styrofoam, plastic, metal, etc)

Any firearm or knives longer than 3 inches in length when closed or longer than 6 inches in length when open

Utility tools (Multi-purpose tool) with a knife blade longer than 3 inches

Displays of the confederate flag

Fireworks, noisemakers, and air horns

Glass or ceramic of any kind & dry ice

Umbrellas

Laser pointers & selfie sticks

Aerosol cans (With the exception of sunscreen, sunblock, hand sanitizer, and bug spray)

Tripods and monopods (Solid or collapsible)

Illegal substances of any kind

Seat cushions with metal components, collapsible chairs & wagons

Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV's), also known as drones

Frisbees, balloons, beach balls, or any other projectile

Skateboards, hoverboards, roller skates, bicycles, or scooters (Lockable bicycle rack is located outside of each admission gate)

Obscene or indecent clothing

• All items brought through the gates are subject to inspection by security and event officials. We must ask that you respect and obey these rules as you spend time at Daytona International Speedway. Failure to do so could result in adjusting the location of your seating/site, or you (and/or your group) being required to leave the premises (no refunds).

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
